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



"Carve-out"


- These services are offered through a separate system (not the state) – county mental health plans.
- Mental health services for serious mental illness (adults) and severe emotional disturbance (children) are an "entitlement."
- Counties may provide services themselves or contract out


Oversight Structure





2015-16 Spending on Public Mental Services


- Mental Health Services Act: Tax on personal income of top 1% of income earners, distributed to counties
- FFP: Federal reimbursement for Medicaid services
- GF: General fund payment for Medi-Cal
- 2011 Realignment: Payments to counties for behavioral health services, from vehicle license fee and sales tax
- State Hospital: Cost of operating state hospitals
- Prison MH: Cost of mental health care for state prison inmates



Does not account for: School-based services; Mental health services delivered by Medi-Cal managed care plans; Local funds; Federal and state grants.

County Mental Health Plans and 1915b Waivers of 1995 and 1997

\$\$\$\$\$\$	Law:
Medi-Cal	 Made mental health an "entitlement" program for certain types of people
	 Certain populations are "entitled" to mental health services:
	adults with serious mental illness
	 and children with severe emotional disturbances.
	 entitled to "specialty mental health services"



Who qualifies for specialty mental health services?

Specialty mental health services are services for people who:

- Have access to Medi-Cal
- Meet medical necessity criteria:
- DSM diagnosis
- Significant impairment or probably of significant deterioration
- Intervention will diminish impairment or prevent deterioration






Type of specialty mental health services

- Mental health services
- Crisis intervention, stabilization, and residential
- Care management
- Medication management
- Inpatient hospitalization
- Rehabilitation


The Realignment Act of 1991

\$\$\$\$\$\$	Law:
tax revenues of:	Health, social services, and public mental health services now controlled by counties
sales tax	County mental health must provide services to certain uninsured populations so long as resources are available.
vehicle license fees	Counties have greater flexibility in spending their funds

Realignment: To cause to form new arrangements or to have a new orientation; to reorganize.






\$\$\$\$\$\$	Law:
1 percent income tax on personal income in excess of \$1 million	the state is required to distribute the funds to county mental health plans
	community services and supports: County mental health programs shall make services available to people with severe illness
	innovations: county mental health plans shall develop plans for innovations
	prevention and early intervention: shall establish a program designed to prevent mental illnesses from becoming severe and disabling.
	workforce education and training: establish a program with dedicated funding to remedy the shortage of qualified individuals to provide services to address severe mental illnesses.
	established the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission




Oversight Structure




\$\$\$\$\$\$\$	Law:
	Expanded mental health benefits in Medi-Cal Managed Care.
	Medi-Cal Managed Care and Fee for Services are responsible for providing services to people with mild to moderate impairments.
	Medi-Cal Managed Care must develop MOUs with county mental health

Low utilization: people are not using the benefit

Specialty Mental Health Services

- Intensive services
- Medi-Cal Eligible
- Medi-Cal Necessity
- Diagnosis
- High-risk

Community Mental Health Services/MHSA

- Prevention and Early Intervention services
- Not Medi-Cal eligible
- Adults and older adults with serious mental disorders
- Children and adolescents w/ serious emotional disturbance

Medi-Cal Managed Care/FFS

- Medi-Cal Eligible
- Medi-Cal Managed Care Plan or Fee for Service (FFS)
- Mild to moderate mental health condition
- does not necessitate specialty services








Accessing mental health services is not easy!













